





Writing better answers using sources for information

<p>Basic</p> 	<p>Mentions things that are in the source such as facts, dates, and opinions.</p>	<p>Stage 1</p>
<p>Intermediate</p> 	<p>Uses several parts of the source to answer the question.</p>	<p>Stage 2</p>
<p>Higher</p> 	<p>Uses several parts of the source in the answer and is critical about the source.</p>	<p>Stage 3</p>
<p>Advanced</p> 	<p>Uses several parts of the source to explain the answer and gives a balanced judgement on the source.</p>	<p>Stage 4</p>
